Detailed description of the project	Services provided
<p>The Global Canopy Program and the Forum on Readiness for REDD initiated the elaboration of the REDD Desk (www.thereddesk.org), an information and exchange platform on the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions from deforestation and forest degradation, including conservation, enhancement of forest carbon stocks and sustainable forest management (REDD+).</p> <p>Hosted by the REDD Desk, the REDD country database's objective is to centralise information on REDD+ in tropical forest countries, using a common analytical framework to facilitate a rapid comparison between countries.</p> <p>Three pilot countries were launched on the platform in May 2011. On this occasion, the Global Canopy Program requested external expertise in order to populate the database.</p> <p>As such the expert participated in the elaboration of Cameroon's country profile, which can be consulted at the following address: www.thereddesk.org/countries/cameroon.</p>	<p>Review of database information and provision of supplements on Cameroon's status regarding REDD+ in terms of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Management and coordination of the REDD+ preparation and implementation processes; • Involvement and participation of stakeholders; • Carbon right and land tenure rights; • Regulatory measures (incentives and enforcement); • Initiatives for the development of REDD+ reference scenarios; • Safeguards design and implementation; • Development of a monitoring, reporting and verification (MRV) system, focused on forest areas and forest carbon stocks.
