- *Analysis and ranking of action: (i) Transversal actions (observation of climate change, water resources or sea level, capacity building, communication and awareness creation, income generating activities, etc.), (ii) Food security (early warning systems, food stocks, food diversification, etc.), (iii) Energy (demand-side policies and energy efficiency, offer-side policies and reforestation, etc.), (iv) Water (irrigation facilities, promotion of irrigated cropping systems, etc.), (v) Protection of coasts (early warning systems, infrastructure, reforestation, etc.), (vi) Fisheries (resource management for inland and marine fisheries, etc.), (vii) Breeding (promotion of fodder, food supplements, improved breeding practices, etc.), (viii) Forests (sustainable forest management, reforestation, fire control, etc.), (ix) crops (agroforestry, improved seeds, crop rotations and/or associations, etc.);*
- *Evaluation of pros and cons of each type of measures, and identification of strategic guidelines for the preparation of National Adaptation Plans (NAPs).*

I confirm that the tasks carried out by Olivier Bouyer, SalvaTerra SAS, were in accordance with the terms of the contract, including the results agreed upon and in respect of the agreed deadlines.
